Showmanship will be held only during the Saturday p.m. show.

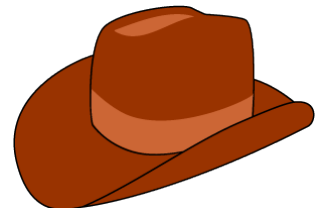
The Saturday a.m. and Sunday a.m. shows will start at 9:00 a.m. These entries will be sent to Pat Kaufmann, PO Box 3285, Los Lunas, NM 87031 or email plkaufm@yahoo.gov. **These entries are due September 6, 2017** - mailed or emailed but all fees must be paid before the shows begin on Saturday. If you are showing the same goats as the state fair show; I can get that information just tell me you are showing the same goats. **You can add or subtract goats for the club sponsored shows. Remember the State Fair Show is the only show that pays premiums though.**

All exhibitors must be in pens, checked in and entries paid for by 9:00 a.m. Saturday, September 16, 2017. There will be a check-in on Friday night from 6 to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 to 8:30 a.m. Again, I'm working on the pen arrangements with the fair because anyone who has been there in the past knows we have had issues getting the Fair staff to clean the pens in a timely manner after the pigs go to auction so we can unload our goats. **If you want bedding in your pens, you must bring it yourself. On Sunday, once the show is completed you are allowed to load up and leave. You do not have to clean your pens after the show, the state fair staff will do that for us.** You must have an exit pass from the superintendent, Pat Kaufmann, before you leave through Gate 6.

All classes for both days are the same class numbers, double check though if you have animals born on the 16th or 17th. State fair health regulations are the same as years past - in-state exhibitors must have Travel Papers from your Livestock Inspector; out-of-town exhibitors need a Health Certificate from your vet. The superintendent and fair vet/livestock staff have the right to send your animals home if they feel they have something that is contagious.

Following the a.m. show on Saturday, we will have lunch. Not sure what we're having yet but plan on staying and eating and visiting with our judges and exhibitors. **The Costume contest will be held this year at noon on Saturday also. We usually draw quite a crowd for that event so plan on participating. All ages.** It can be any kind of goat; person and goat must be dressed in a costume. We will have 4 age groups for this contest and prizes will be awarded per age group. Adults can also be in this contest!!
