## **Fees:**

- Showmanship is free. All other classes \$8.00 per goat/class/show for members. Otherwise classes are \$10.00 per goat/class/show. Mail or email your entries to Renee at 7003 Loma Larga, Corrales NM 87048. Needed changes on goats by exhibitors that have entered, can be done at check in. If you have a break down or are arriving later than planned. Please call Renee at (505) 459-7891 Heather (575)405-8287. ASAP.
- Online entries preferred. US mail entries deadline is Oct. 19 at 5:00pm MT. No refunds will be given after entries are received. Please, all in-state exhibitors send a check with your entries!

## **Show Arrival:**

- The arena will be available on Friday, Oct. 26th, 2018 for set up. You can come in on Saturday morning as well. Animals can stay on the grounds both Friday and Saturday nights. Both shows are held on Saturday. Note: this is a private property, and we want to be on our best behavior and follow directions from the owners.

## **Show Schedule:**

- Check in will be on Friday from late morning-early afternoon, and again on Saturday starting at 8:00 am. The show starts at 9:00 am. Please make sure you have your paperwork in early!
- All paperwork for both shows will need to be completed and paid for, before you enter the ring. We will offer Master champions classes for both shows!
- It is your responsibly to make sure you've entered your animals in the right classes and bring a reader if you are microchipping your animals (new chips are 12 code, not all readers pick this up), so bring your reader. Once the goat enters a class it cannot be returned in another class. This is per NPGA Rules.

## **Animal Identification and Paperwork:**

- All animals must have original NPGA Registration Papers to enter the show. No Photocopies. Newly purchased animals, will need a bill of sale that is marked less than 90 days from show date (September 19, 2015) along with the original registration paper! Any animal winning a Grand or Reserve Grand Championship must have a legible tattoo or microchip in order to record a win. The judge will have the final say if a win is recorded or not. Don't forget to check your microchips/tattoos, so that you don't lose a win!

#### **Pens:**

- You will need to bring your own travel pens to unload animals. If you choose to keep them in your trailer-that's okay. All parking will be directed by the owners or Bruce. Please be patient, and they will fit you in. Caution there are no lights in the arena, so you should plan accordingly. I live less than five minutes from the arena and will meet you there to help with this if needed. All pens will be placed in the arena. You can set up anywhere you'd like, but use caution as animals could have gotten out of pens and could be loose.

#### **Sick Animals:**

- Any animals deemed ill by the G. O. Farm or contracted Judges, will be withdrawn from the competition. Refunds will not be given. Please do not bring sick animals.

#### **Hotels:**

- We have a host hotel in Rio Rancho. The extended Stay America at 2221 Pat D' Arco. Better known as (Hwy. 528), Rio Rancho NM 87124. To get the room at 20% off you will need to email Theresa Olivera at [abr@esa.com](mailto:abr@esa.com). One night is \$49.39 plus tax. Two nights is \$111.08! Can't beat this price, but book early as its not a huge hotel. You are less than 10 minutes to the arena in Corrales at the G. O. Farm. Tell them you coming to the Goat show on the 27<sup>th</sup> of Oct. 2018.

**Note:** obey the speed limits in Corrales as we have unmarked trucks and cars that patrol. They would relish the opportunity to pull you over for a chat and a summons.

#### **Meal and Raffle Corner:**

- Do your own thing for Breakfast. We will break between shows for lunch and then have a judge's dinner after the show. We will have a raffle with proceeds to go to Corrales Kids Ranch to help pay for the costs of the show. Any donations are greatly appreciated.

#### **Directions:**

The G. O. Farm is in Corrales NM which is a suburb of Albuquerque's West side, is across the Rio Grande River. Corrales is a small agriculture community located between Albuquerque & Rio Rancho.

- Coming from North of Albuquerque. From I-25 heading South, take Exit 242 Hwy 550 into Bernalillo. Head West on Hwy 550 for 2.4 miles, crossing over the Rio Grande River. Turn left at traffic light just past the "Star Casino" to Hwy 528 heading to Corrales and Rio Rancho. Travel (south) on Hwy 528 for 4.7 miles turn left at traffic light (and a Conoco station) onto Corrales Road. Paseo Cesar Chavez (brown sign), is about a mile as you enter into Corrales on your right. If you drive past the tree farm, you've gone too far.
- Coming from the East or South of town. Take I-40 West to I-25 North. Travel north on I-25 about 5 miles to the Alameda exit (just past Paseo Del Norte exit). The Alameda exit is on your right. Take the first left at light going west on Alameda for about 5 miles. Go over Rio Grande River, heading West and turn north onto Corrales Road. Follow about another 6 miles. You will have to go through essentially all of Corrales. At the end you will pass a big tree farm on the right. Paseo Cesar Chavez (brown sign) is on your left. Once on Paseo Cesar Chavez, you will see ahead of you very tall Horse Arena and barns. Most of the land around it is vacant. You can't miss it. The old sign says Larrabee's. Right turn into farm property.
